#### Ephesians 5:17-20

<sup>17</sup>Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the Lord's will is. <sup>18</sup>Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery. Instead, be filled with the Spirit, <sup>19</sup>speaking to one another with psalms,

hymns, and songs from the Spirit. Sing and make music from your heart to the Lord, <sup>20</sup>always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

#### Isaiah 5:22

<sup>22</sup>What sorrow for those who are heroes at drinking wine and boast about all the alcohol they can hold.
