### HABITS:

1. **WORSHIP** - The practice of private surrender
2. **MEDITATION** - Hearing God's voice through His word

5. **BREAKING BREAD** - Drawing from the Body & Blood of Jesus
6. **SPIRITUAL GIFTS** - Grace gifts release grace

### HABIT 7: Going

**ILLUST:** One of the big lessons I learnt from Covid pandemic - I need to go for the gospel!

- Going enlarges me and my vision
- World seems to shrink when I am just at home
- Pressures and details and daily grind
- But when I go, my vision expands

**Notice how this was worked it with Jesus' disciples:**

*Luke 10:1 (NIV)*

*1 After this the Lord appointed seventy-two others and sent them two by two ahead of him to every town and place where he was about to go.*

*Luke 10:17 (NIV)*

*17 The seventy-two returned with joy and said, "Lord, even the demons submit to us in your name."*

**They must have gone out with:**

- Fear
- Nervous about their ability
- Not knowing what to expect

**They returned:**

- With joy! They had seen the hand of God at work
- Excitement - they had experienced God using them
- Vision - had got a glimpse of their future

**This is why going is so powerful**

- It takes you out of your comfort zone
- It puts you in the middle of the Great Commission
- It makes you fully dependant on God

**Testimony:** Going on an international trip to South America

- Always wondered about Jesus telling his disciples not to take extra money, bag or clothes
- Surely that s not realistic nowadays
- Didn’t have much cash at all
- Only use my credit card
- It was blocked for international travel that trip!
- Came back with more money than I started - everyone just gave me gifts!

**PRACTICAL:**

- Commit to an outreach every year
- Make it a daily goal to share the gospel with someone
