#### 6. Spirit filled mission

Acts 8:4-8 (NLT)

4 But the believers who were scattered preached the Good News about Jesus wherever they went. 5 Philip, for example, went to the city of Samaria and told the people there about the Messiah. 6 Crowds listened intently to Philip because they were eager to hear his message and see the miraculous signs he did. 7 Many evil spirits were cast out, screaming as they left their victims. And many who had been paralyzed or lame were healed. 8 So there was great joy in that city.

The sixth growth trigger is about building a sense of mission into the church. Choose Acts 1:8 so that God doesn't have to choose Acts 8:1 for you!

# Acts 1:8 gives four spheres of influence every Base Church should aim to have a footprint in:

- Jerusalem your city of town
- Judea the region or province around you
- Samaria the nations next door
- Ends of the earth the nations far away

Gen 12:1-3 speaks of the Apostolic blessing of going! Trust God and live to be a blessing to the nations!

BIG IDEA: Don't wait to be big to be a BASE. "Start like you want to finish" and set the example early on!
